Outline new Policy Plan 2022-2025

Musicians

- For Jumpstart Jr. instruments, a loan period of 7 years applies.
- The annual contribution for each Jumpstart Jr. musician is €600.
- In the annual meeting with the directors and the Jumpstart Jr. musician the use of the JJJF instrument and the progress and development of the musician's career will be discussed.
- Auditions for violin will be organized in June 2022 and for cello in 2023.
- We aim to organize a big event for the JJJF musicians in this policy period.

Instruments

- Each instrument is examined annually by a well-known luthier and repaired if necessary.
- Any major restoration work maintenance of the instrument will take place at the end of a loan period.
- The Jumpstart Jr. instruments will be valued every 3 years. The Sparey instruments will be valued every 5 years, except for the Andrea Amati violin and the Vuillaume viola, which are valued every 3 years.
- In December 2021 a partnership was established with the National Musical Instruments Fund (NMF) to work together to find and select suitable musicians for the instruments of the Sparey Collection. In 2022, 4 violins and a viola will be transferred to the NMF, and in 2024 another 5 violins will follow, from now on called 'The Jumpstart-Sparey collection'.

Communication & PR

- Jumpstart Jr. Foundation is not a fundraising foundation and therefore all activities for and with the public will only be organized if this is in direct or indirect interest of the Jumpstart Jr. musicians
- Social media will be used more intensively to generate more awareness for the JJJF musicians. A plan will be drawn up for this purpose, which will be implemented in mid-2022.

Organization

- No changes in the organization or the staff of the Jumpstart Jr. Foundation are expected.
